## **REQUIRED INFORMATION**

#### LIST OF DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO SUBMIT APPLICATION

- certificate of enrollment from home university
- ✓ a copy of identity card (European students)
- ✓ a copy of up-to-date passport (International students)
- ✓ foreign student civil liability insurance (can be purchased in France via <u>Heyme</u>)
- a learning agreement or OLA (Erasmus students) duly signed by home university
- a certificate of language level (depending on the choice of program) from home university.

## **LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT**

- level B1 (minimum) to attend courses in French
   (entire Bachelor3 program and most of Master1 courses)
- C2 for courses taught in English (30% of Master1 projects and elective courses, International Master or Miv-TTT program)

**ACADEMIC YEAR:** 34 weeks: 2 terms of 17 weeks

#### ACADEMIC CALENDAR

### **CROUS-VERSAILLES RESIDENCES**

## **WELCOME DAY**

This event enables international students to get valuable assistance in completing all the administrative procedures they need to deal with at ENSA Versailles. But mostly, they will be informed in advance of the current semester program and any new developments. It will also help them to contact the different internal or local services of ENSA Versailles.
