Nomination via e- mail

Exchange students must be selected by their home institution, according to the conditions and number of places of the bilateral agreement.

Partner universities should communicate the nominated candidates before **May 15**th to ETSAB International Office by e-mail at <a href="mailto:mob.etsab@upc.edu">mob.etsab@upc.edu</a> indicating: students' name, email, current studies and period of stay (for non-UE students: please add ID/passport number) Instructions for online application will be sent in return to the nominated students

Online Application

Exchange students must then **apply online for admission** between April 1<sup>st</sup> and **May 31<sup>st</sup>** at: https://prisma-nou.upc.edu/apl/home\_preinscripcio.php?idioma=3#

Online Application: Fill in the required data + Upload the following files:

- ETSAB Exchange Application Form dully filled in, signed by their mobility coordinator
- Copy of passport or ID card
- Academic Records, with number of credits achieved/total credits of the current degree

Additional documents

No other documents are needed at this moment.

Upon arrival, students may bring with them a curriculum vitae and a graphic portfolio with samples of their work, to show to their ETSAB academic advisor.

Learning Agreement

Follow the indications on How to prepare your LEARNING AGREEMENT (Before the Mobility)

This first version of the LEARNING AGREEMENT will be provisionally signed by ETSAB International Office (or validated online via EWP-Erasmus Without Papers when possible) and IT DOES NOT IMPLY A RESERVATION OF THE CHOSEN COURSES.

The availability of subjects and class groups will only be known at the moment of enrolment and changes are very likely to happen.

Once the enrolment at ETSAB is fully completed (including changes periods in September & January) ETSAB International Office will sign or validate online via EWP the EXCEPTIONAL CHANGES in the LEARNING AGREEMENT accordingly.

Mandatory Insurance

It is mandatory that all exchange and visiting students coming to UPC book a private insurance that covers them for their stay, which includes health assistance (including diagnostic tests and surgical interventions), accidents, (compensation for permanent disability and death compensation), repatriation and civil liability.

**EU students**. Students from the European Union (or Norway or Switzerland) need to have both the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) and an additional private insurance. Upon arrival and before the enrolment at ETSAB, students will be asked to hand in an INSURANCE STATEMENT document duly completed and signed, with a copy of the insurance policy contracted with these coverages.

## **Academic Calendar** First semester: from early September to end of January from February to end of June Second semester: \*accurate calendar will be known later on Preferred period of stay Depending on the bilateral agreement, the stay may be for one year or one semester. In the case of agreements for annual stays, semestral stays are also accepted, but only in the first term (September-January). The number of places remains unchanged, regardless of the duration of the stay. Problems for study in IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO COME JUST FOR THE SECOND SEMESTER (February -June) 2<sup>nd</sup> semester Enrolment of incoming students takes place in September for the full year ONLY when specified at the bilateral agreement, or very exceptionally at request of the partner university, ETSAB may authorize second semester stays. Important note: the academic offer will be adjusted to the availability at the time of arrival Academic structure http://etsab.upc.edu/en/international/incoming/study-at-etsab ETSAB ARCHITECTURE studies are organized into a 5+1 years structure: **GRADO EN ESTUDIOS DE ARQUITECTURA** (Degree in Architecture Studies) **GArqEtsaB** = 300 ECTS in 5 years MASTER UNIVERSITARIO EN ARQUITECTURA (Master's Degree in Architecture) MArgEtsaB = 60 ECTS in 1 year GArqEtsaB along with MArqEtsaB is an integrated academic programme that enables the practice as Architect in Spain (regulated profession) POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES ETSAB has restructured its postgraduate academic offer, merging most former Master Degree programmes, which in general are not offered to exchange and visiting students. MASTER UNIVERSITARIO EN PAISAJISMO (Master's Degree in Landscape Architecture) MBLandArch = 120 ECTS in 2 years MASTER UNIVERSITARIO EN ESTUDIOS AVANZADOS EN ARQUITECTURA-BARCELONA (Master's degree in Advanced Studies in Architecture-Barcelona) MBArch = 60 ECTS in 1 year, 9 different tracks MASTER UNIVERSITARIO EN ESTUDIOS AVANZADOS EN DISEÑO-BARCELONA (Master's degree in Advanced Studies in Design-Barcelona) MBDesign = 60 ECTS in 1 year, 5 different tracks Academic offer Incoming Exchange students will enrol courses of GRADO EN ESTUDIOS DE ARQUITECTURA Courses available for GArqEtsaB. exchange students Academic offer details are updated every year in July (elective courses offer, class schedules...) Besides, MASTER UNIVERSITARIO EN PAISAJISMO MBLandArch courses are available only for Erasmus+ and EMiLA Landscape students when specified in the Bilateral Agreement. Other ETSAB's study programmes (MArqEtsaB, MBArch or MBDesign) are NOT included in Exchange Bilateral Agreements. Exceptionally, some MBArch elective courses taught in English may be offered ONLY TO THOSE EXCHANGE STUDENTS WITH MORE THAN 180 ECTS (equal to 6 semesters) already achieved in their previous Architecture studies. (Not applicable to SICUE and Visiting students) Advanced knowledge It is strongly recommended that, upon arrival, Architecture exchange students have preferred completed 6 semesters at their home university (180 ECTS credits). **Enrolment** Annual enrolment in September, both autumn and spring semester subjects must be chosen. Changes only allowed at specific dates of September & January It is recommended not to take more than 5-6 subjects (24-30 ECTS) per semester Enrolment criteria for (Visiting students at undergraduate degrees (grados) are allowed to enrol a maximum of 60 exchange students (visiting students) ECTS credits during their stay at UPC) • Compulsory subjects from 1st to 5th year: They may enrol any subject of their interest, choosing the semester, according to the availability of class groups. >> Maximum 1 Architectural Design Studio + 1 Urban Planning Studio per semester • Elective subjects have a limited number of places. While reserving a percentage of them for exchange/visiting we cannot guarantee its availability for all students. Their schedule may overlap with compulsory courses

>> Maximum 2-3 elective courses per semester, according to availability
• Final Thesis Project (TFG) is not open to incoming exchange/visiting students

Medium of instruction Language for exchange students	SPANISH and CATALAN are the languages of instruction at ETSAB Architecture Degree classes, although some elective subjects and specific class groups in Arch. Design & Urban Design Studios and other core subjects are offered in ENGLISH, with limited places available.
Language requirements	ETSAB strongly recommend having at least a B1 level of Spanish before arrival.  Incoming students are not required to submit a proof of Spanish or Catalan language skills, however partner universities should take that into consideration for nomination.
