Deadlines:	The application deadlines are as follows:
	• 6 June 2023 for September 2023 entry (Autumn/Winter Term)
	or full year 2023/2024.
	 31 October 2023 for January 2024 entry (Spring Term).

What a student is required to supply/upload with application:

- 1. Passport Bio detail page.
- 2. Official latest transcript.
- 3. Head & Shoulder Picture (for production of Student ID card both electronic and physical card).
- 4. Proof of English (unless English is your first language). This is compulsory if studying for the full year.

Portfolio requirement:

Students who are applying for courses in Architecture, Art Direction, Fashion, Graphic Design, Illustration Animation, Interior Design, Fine Art, Filmmaking or Photography will need to provide a portfolio and you will be sent instructions to send/upload this after your application has been made or use any one of the following.

Portfolios can be sent/provided using the following methods:

- If under 20 MB by email in .pdf format to a.russell@kingston.ac.uk
- Any size by WE Transfer or digital drop box to a.russell@kingston.ac.uk
- If it's available by website/weblink only then please email the relevant link to a.russell@kingston.ac.uk

Usually up to 1 month after the application deadline.

Teaching Block 1 (Autumn 2023):

Induction week: Monday 18 September 2023 to Friday 22 September 2023. (International students may be asked to arrive by Wednesday 13 September but tbc).

Please note we don't have the semester system here at Kingston University but shorter teaching blocks! Teaching weeks: Monday 25 September 2023 to Friday 15 December 2023*.

*Please note that this end date may vary for each course and assignments might be required to be submitted online after this date. These can be submitted remotely. Please check with the Study Abroad Administrator when applying.

Teaching Block 2 (Spring 2024):

Teaching weeks: Monday 8 January 2024 to Friday 29 March 2024 (however for Design you may be required to stay later (currently TBC).

(Students may be asked to arrive by Friday 5 January 2024 for induction but tbc).
