## Recommended language skills

French is our main teaching language. There are no formal language requirements for incoming students at Ensa Paris-Est.

**However, to attend bachelors' level classes, intermediate level of French (B1 or B2 level) is highly recommended before arrival. To attend masters' level classes, a C1 level of French is recommended before arrival.**

Some classes are taught in English for postgraduate students. A B2-C1 English level is also recommended to attend those classes.

Incoming students are able to attend a 30-hour French class, and architectural visits in Paris guided by an architect take place at the beginning of September during the week.

## Further information

Classes will generally start on the second week of September for fall term, and on the first week of February for spring term.

Incoming students should go to the International Office as soon as they get on campus to register, collect their student badge, and to have their Certificate of Arrival filled out and signed.

## Intensive French course
