Abstract:

This work investigated internal and external factors affecting balance control, such as internal body representations, the type of tactile interaction, and vibrotactile biofeedback encodings. This thesis further proposes a generative integrative framework of embodied cognition in the world, emphasising the importance of body schema and discussing plausible mechanisms, like the Passive Motion Paradigm and Active Inference.
