Health Insurance	In addition to the obligatory GJU Health Insurance, we recommend our Incoming Students to get an International Health Insurance for more comprehensive coverage. Personal Liability Insurance is not required.
Visa for 6 Months	<p>A one-month visa can be purchased on arrival at the airport in Amman for 40 JOD. Later on it must be extended twice (6 months in total).</p> <p>Also check out the possibility of purchasing the Jordan Pass (https://www.jordanpass.jo/)</p>
Visa for more than 6 Months	<p>For a second semester at GJU: The IAD will support you with getting the Residency Permit from the Jordanian Ministry of Interior.</p> <p>For an internship: The company is responsible for providing a Residence Permit for the period of the internship.</p>
