Criteria	Conclusion
summa cum laude	For the assessment "summa cum laude" (PromO 2021) / "passed with high distinction (summa cum laude)" (PromO 2012), "1,0" (PromO 2001), three reports with the assessment "summa cum laude" are necessary. If only two examiners have been appointed, a third examiner must be appointed during the current procedure. One examiner must be external.
co-authorship	At least one examiner is not allowed to be a co-author of the paper-based dissertation.
