

Guidelines for the evaluation of the dissertation for the doctoral programs Experimental Medicine and Translational Medicine, and the medical doctoral programs Dr. med. and Dr. med. dent., based on the Regulations for the Award of Doctoral Degrees of the Technical University of Munich, effective October 1st, 2021 and the Decision of the Faculty Council of the School of Medicine of January 26th, 2022.

Evaluation	Earlier grading for comparison*	Criteria
		The quality of the dissertation content is assessed by taking into account the central aspects of the scientific performance. These include: originality, innovation, relevance, scope of scientific achievements, scientific independence, quality and significance of the control tests.
Bestanden - summa cum laude	1,0	The performance must be predominantly very good to outstanding concerning the aspects given above. Additionally, at least one original paper, with the doctoral candidate as first author, must have been accepted for publication in an English-language peer-reviewed journal.
Bestanden - magna cum laude	1,3 – 1,7	The performance must be predominantly very good concerning the aspects given above.
Bestanden	2,0 – 4,0	The performance must be predominantly good to sufficient concerning the aspects given above. An independent scientific work with a gain of knowledge is a prerequisite for passing.
Nicht bestanden	4,3 – 5,0	Poor scientific performance.

* These grades are only comparative values for the assessment and should not appear on the review.
