

Institutions for internships

The following list provides an overview about **suggestions** for internships. Internships can also be completed at other institutions.

Before contacting people from that list and sending your application, **you have to inform yourself about the institution, read about the required prerequisites** and prepare a specific cover letter.

How to write your inquiry/cover letter

- Your first inquiry and cover letter may make the difference between obtaining an interview or having your resume ignored, so it makes good sense to devote the necessary time and effort to writing inquiries/ effective cover letters
- If you are just firstly asking for a possibility via e-mail, it is important to make a good first impression:
address a person (not only: regards), be polite
explain context, interest and reason why you would like to receive insight
- A cover letter is often your earliest written contact with a potential employer, creating a critical first impression.
- Your cover letter should be designed specifically for each position you seek. Do not design a form letter and send it to every potential employer (you know what you do with junk mail!)
- Effective cover letters explain the reasons for your interest in the specific organization and identify your most relevant skills or experiences. The letter should express a high level of interest and knowledge about the position.
- If you receive an invitation for an interview: **be on time!**
